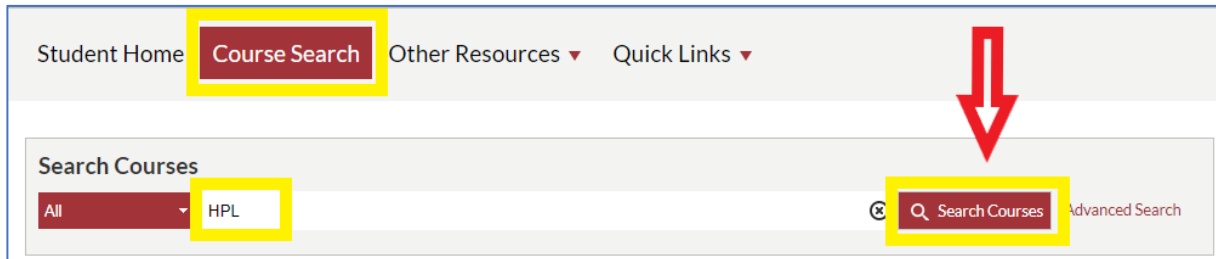


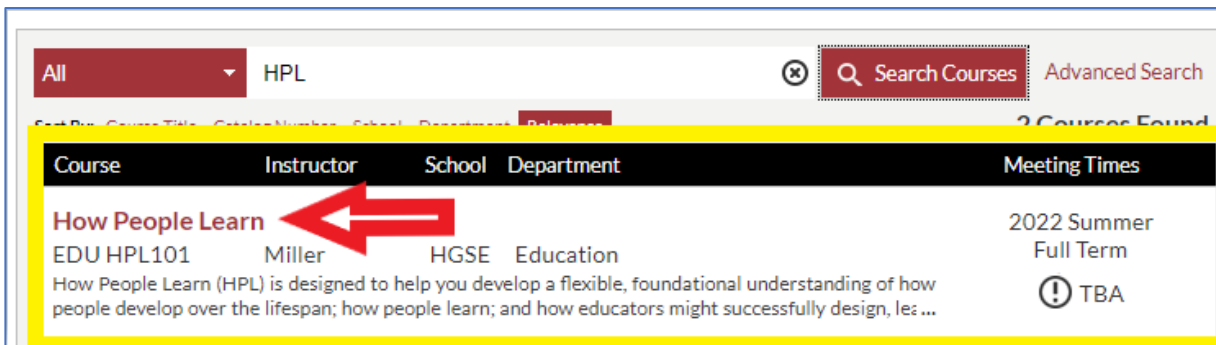


How to Enroll in How People Learn

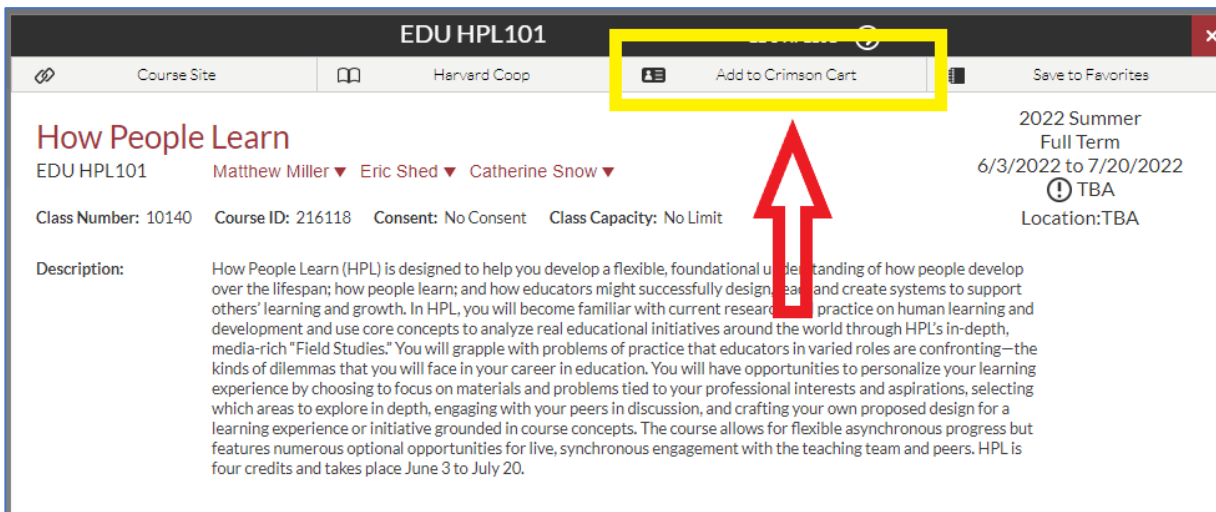
1. Log in to my.Harvard using your Harvard Key. Navigate to “Course Search” and type HPL. Click “Search Courses.”
