I just want to send you a quick email with the following important **January Term** reminders:

1. The Registration deadline for January Term enrollment is tomorrow, **Friday, December 2nd at 11:59pm ET**. All courses will require instructor consent after this deadline.
2. January Term enrollment is completely optional.
3. January Term credits do not count against Spring Term credit maximums for any students. These credits will not reduce the maximum available credits in Spring 2023.
4. The add/drop deadline for January Term courses is one hour before the start of the second lecture for each class. ([Drop deadline will vary by course.](#)) Please check the "Class Notes" section for each class for the specific add/drop/change of grading basis deadline.
5. As mentioned before, enrollment and registration holds were ignored for the lottery-based enrollment event. Students have until Friday, December 2 at 12:00pm ET to clear any holds. (Students with vaccination appointments can contact HUHS to temporarily lift those holds.)
