Many of you expressed an interest in a Concentration on your HGSE admissions application. Please note that any interest expressed at that time was non-binding.

In order to pursue a Concentration, you must declare your intention to do so via my.harvard by Monday, August 22 at 5pm Eastern Daylight Time. <u>Please click here for instructions on how to complete the process</u>. Declaring a Concentration will signal to the Concentration faculty that you plan to join their cohort this fall.

Please take the time you need to decide which Concentration, if any, best fits your interests—and remember that declaring a Concentration is completely optional. The Concentration Co-Chairs of each concentration will host a Q&A Session on **Wednesday**, **August 17**. Times and locations vary.
