My.Harvard Check-In

As a reminder, **all students are required to check-in for the fall semester**. You will be able to complete the check-in process by following [these steps](#). When you have completed the Check-in process, you will be able to move forward to enroll in classes. **Please note that the my.Harvard Check-in is a required process for each semester at HGSE**. You need to complete 3 my.harvard Check-in processes during the year (summer, fall, and spring).

Lottery-Based Enrollment

The [Fall Term Lottery-based enrollment](#) for HGSE courses will open in my.Harvard on Wednesday, August 24 at 12:01am ET, and will remain so until Tuesday, August 30 when it will close at 11:59am ET. **Please note that you do NOT need to add Lottery-Based enrollment courses to your Crimson Cart or submit a petition; all you need to do is enter the Lottery-based enrollment process and rank your choices.** [Please click here for the Lottery-based enrollment "How to" guideline](#).

You will find the lottery-based preferences (rank your choices) page in my.Harvard. While the lottery is open, you will be able to add, delete, or change your course ranked choices. The results of the lottery-based enrollment will be posted in my.Harvard on Tuesday, August 30 in the evening (no later than 11:59pm ET). You will receive an email communication once it has been completed.

Instructor Permission Enrollment

Instructor permission courses are courses that require specific prerequisites that are reviewed by the instructor. In many cases, courses that require instructor permission are requirements for a program or concentration. In order

to enroll in an instructor permission course, [please submit a petition via my.harvard](#). Please check the course description and/or the course website for additional instructions, if any, before submitting your petition. You can start submitting petitions tomorrow, Wednesday, August 24. **Please note that when your petition has been approved, do not forget to enroll in the course!**
