### **Foundations Course Enrollment**

As a reminder, Foundations courses are required for the Ed.M. degree and students are expected to be in residence and available during the times when Foundations courses are offered in August, **beginning on August 5<sup>th</sup>**. In addition, it is expected that you will attend the Welcome Day on August 2<sup>nd</sup>. Please visit the Registrar’s web page on [Foundations for Residential Ed.M. students](#) for the dates of each course.

**Part-time students** must complete the three August Foundations courses over their two years in residence. **All part-time students must notify the Registrar about any August courses you wish to take in 2024.** If you plan to enroll in Leading Change (LCH101) or Evidence (EVI101) in August 2024, please email [registrar@gse.harvard.edu](mailto:registrar@gse.harvard.edu) by **Monday, July 8<sup>th</sup> at 11:59 pm ET** to request enrollment. If you wish to enroll in Equity & Opportunity: Identity in Context (EQO11), please complete the lottery process described below by July 8 to indicate your intent to enroll.

**Equity & Opportunity: Identity in Context (EQO11)** [Action Required: Must complete by Monday July 8<sup>th</sup>, 2024]

As part of your Foundations experience in Equity & Opportunity, all residential Ed.M. students will take an August Term “Identity in Context” course. As [described elsewhere](#), the Identity in Context courses immerse you in inquiry about one of six dimensions of social identity: Class, Dis/ability, Gender & Sexuality, Race & Ethnicity, Citizenship & Nationality, or Language. With this email **you are invited to indicate your preferences among these six topics within My.Harvard**. Your preferences will be taken into account when placing you in August course sections. Note that we encourage you to prioritize topics that are relatively new to you—academically, experientially, or both.

To help you identify your topic preferences for Identity in Context, **we encourage you to explore the information and resources available on the E&O Foundations Canvas**

This site includes guidance from the E&O faculty, reflections from past students, examples of course readings and guiding questions, and access to a self-assessment developed by HGSE faculty members to help you reflect on your growth edges.

**Please click here for instructions** on how to use the “lottery event” feature in **My.Harvard** to submit your topic preferences for Equity & Opportunity: Identity in Context. You will be able to enter your preferences starting Friday, June 21<sup>st</sup>. **The deadline to submit your topic preferences is Monday, July 8<sup>th</sup> at 11:59 pm ET.** Please note that **if you do not enter your preferences before the deadline, you will not be enrolled in Identity in Context in 2024.**

**The Office of the Registrar will officially enroll you in your chosen August-Term Foundations courses after the E&O lottery event closes.** On **Monday, July 15<sup>th</sup>** you will see your placement in all three August Foundations courses in My.harvard.

**\*\*\*IMPORTANT NOTE\*\*\*** Please note that enrollment and registration holds will be ignored for the Foundations course registration process. **HOWEVER**, you have until 12:00 pm ET on Friday, August 2<sup>nd</sup> to clear your holds, if any, or your Foundations courses (LCH101, EVI101, and EQO11) will be dropped from your record.
