Harvard Student ID Cards

Harvard ID cards for new students who uploaded their photo by the deadline will be distributed under the tent in Radcliffe Yard on Friday, August 2, from noon to 1 PM during Welcome Day. If you miss the card distribution in Radcliffe Yard, you can stop by the Office of the Registrar, located in Longfellow G006, to pick up your ID card. Cards will be available for pick up at our office until Friday, August 9.

Registration 101 Sessions

The upcoming Registration 101 sessions, scheduled for **August 7, August 13, and August 15 from 1:00 PM to 2:00 PM**, will provide essential information for students about the registration process

for the upcoming Fall Term. These sessions will cover important topics such as course basics, enrollment policies, and the specifics of how to navigate cross-registration opportunities. Students will also learn about the various credit types, enrollment timelines, and procedures for limited-enrollment courses, ensuring that all participants are well-prepared to manage their course selections. **Please note that each session will cover the same information, so students can choose to attend the one that best fits their schedule. The sessions will be hosted in Askwith Hall in the Longfellow Building.**

HGSE 2024-25 Course Catalog

An initial release of the course catalog became available on Monday, July 15 via the “Course Search” tab inside [my.Harvard](https://my.harvard.edu). Note that course offerings are not yet complete, and details are subject to change. Additional courses will be added in the coming weeks. Please consider the following when searching our course catalog.

Important notes:

- This is an initial batch of course information with **further courses to be added and corrections to be made** over the following weeks through August.
- Course meeting times often must be revised during August, so **some dates and times of courses will change up until the course previews and enrollment week in late August.**
- **Students should not yet plan on which elective courses to take.** Programs will share more information about program-specific course requirements by mid-August. During the week of August 26th, students will have the opportunity to view course previews and consult with faculty advisors before deciding on which elective courses to take. We are making this preliminary version of the catalogue available now for browsing and initial planning.
