S998: EdLD LEADERSHIP FELLOWSHIP LEARNING CONTRACT AND POLICIES

Enrollment is limited to students in the EdLD Program. The course is a 2 – credit course taken SAT/No Credit. There is no letter grade option. Students complete a minimum 125-hour fellowship for this course.

As a complement to Workplace Lab and its focus on sector change, students will work on root cause analysis, problem definitions, theories of action, small wins, building credibility, overcoming resistance, and achieving results that have impact. Students will focus on either:

Students enrolled in this course will demonstrate and practice the knowledge, skills, habits of mind and ability to lead system level change within organizations.

Fieldwork experiences will be enhanced by the support of an executive mentor with whom you will work and an executive coach, who will provide support and guidance. Executive coaches are seasoned system level leaders who support student progress and growth.

It is important to set clear learning goals and expectations for the scope of work and time commitment at the fieldwork sites for the semester.

There will be at least 3 three-way meetings during the semester—one at the beginning, one at the midpoint, and one at the end. These meetings will include the executive mentor, the executive coach, and you. You are responsible for scheduling and preparing agendas for these meetings.

If you plan to pursue School Superintendent Licensure, you will be required to submit a Practicum Report Form that confirms meetings and standards addressed during fieldwork. This form will be provided to you by the Program and posted on the canvas site.

You will keep and submit logs and reflections/insights bi-weekly and match them to Massachusetts DESE state standards and post them to the Canvas website every two weeks for review on the form provided in the syllabus.

At the end of the commitment, the Executive Leadership Mentor will complete a form provided by HGSE to assess whether you have fulfilled the stated hours and agreed upon work. You will write a final learning reflection paper about the experience.

The Faculty Lead, who signs the Learning Contract, will determine your final grade by 1] considering your bi-weekly logs and reflections, 2] your final written reflection, 3] the assessments from your site executive mentor and coach and, 4] the completion of your 125 fellowship hours.
