## **HGSE Courses**

Courses offered during the Spring Semester 2024 are viewable in <u>my.Harvard</u>. Please be aware that additions and changes will be made right up until the time of course enrollment. For that reason, it is a good idea to check the listing frequently. You can also find any course updates by visiting our <u>Course Catalog Updates page</u>.

### **Enrollment Overview**

Course enrollment is split into three primary phases:

- **Pre-Enrollment:** Wednesday, January 10 Tuesday, January 17 (Lottery-based enrollment ranking and placement; Add courses to your Crimson Cart; Submit petitions for instructor permission courses that are not in the lottery)
- Open-Enrollment Period: Thursday, January 18 Friday, January 19 at 3:00pm ET (Enroll in open-enrollment courses; Enroll in instructor permission courses; Modify enrollments for lottery-based courses; Join waitlists for lottery-based courses that are full). After January 19, all courses require instructor approval

Add/Drop/grade option change deadline: Monday, February 5 at 11:59PM ET (Spring Full Term
& Spring 1 Modules)

### **Course Previews**

Students will have two opportunities to preview HGSE classes in advance of course enrollment:

1. By viewing 8-10-minute pre-recorded videos created by the course instructors and posted to their (Canvas) course websites. These videos will be made available to students on **Friday**, **January 12**.

\*\*\*IMPORTANT\*\*\* It is highly recommended that you watch the pre-recorded videos before attending the Live Q&A sessions.

2. By attending live, 25-minute question and answer sessions. Spring Q&A sessions will be scheduled on Tuesday, January 16, and Wednesday, January 17. The preview schedule will be posted to my. Harvard on Friday, January 12. These live sessions will also be recorded and posted to course websites.

# My.Harvard Check-In

Check-In in my.Harvard will begin on Wednesday, January 10 (at 12:01 a.m. ET). You will be able to complete the check-in process by following <a href="mailto:these-steps">these-steps</a>. The deadline to check-in in <a href="may.Harvard">my.Harvard</a> is Friday, January 19. After January 20, students will be allowed to do late check-in through Monday, February 6, at which time check-in will close. **All students are required to check-in for the spring semester.** When you have completed the Check-in process, you will be able to move forward to enroll in classes.

# **Lottery-Based Enrollment**

The Spring Semester lottery-based enrollment for HGSE courses will open in my.Harvard on Wednesday, January 10 at 12:01am ET, and will remain so until Wednesday, January 17 when it will close at 2:00pm ET. You will find the lottery-based preferences (rank your choices) page in my.Harvard. While the lottery is open, you will be able to add, delete, or change your course ranked choices. The results of the lottery-based enrollment will be posted in my.Harvard on Wednesday, January 17 in the evening (no later than 11:59pm). You will receive an email communication once it has been completed.

# **Cross-Registration**

Like HGSE course registration, cross-registration into any of the other Harvard schools and MIT is done through my.harvard. Please visit our <u>Cross Registration page</u> for additional information.

Please note that on Wednesday, January 10, you may add courses to your Crimson Cart – This means that you can start adding courses at other Harvard Schools and MIT to your Crimson Cart. This will allow you to validate and submit petitions for instructor permission courses. Holds do not impact your ability to add courses to your Crimson Cart and submit petitions!

### \*\*\*IMPORTANT\*\*\*

Due to differences in the academic calendars of the Harvard Graduate School of Education (HGSE) and the Massachusetts Institute of Technology (MIT), students are cautioned that some MIT courses that require instructor permission/approval start after our add/drop deadline; this might prevent you from registering. As a reminder, you need to follow the earliest deadline of both institutions, in this case, HGSE add/drop deadline is first. In addition, Spring grades for MIT courses may not be received in time to count towards May 2024 graduation. If students wish to receive their diploma on time, they should carefully consider whether to take an MIT course in the final semester. ## **E&O Foundations Elective Course Requirement (Residential Ed.M. Students)**

As a reminder, all Ed.M. students who will graduate in May 2024 must complete their E&O Foundations elective requirement before May Term by choosing a course from the list on the E&O Foundations Canvas website. Those wishing to petition for an unlisted course to count toward their E&O Foundations must do so by January 30, 2024, at 5 pm ET. Any petitions received after January 30 will not be accepted. Instructions for submitting a petition may be found on the E&O Canvas site.
